BridgeView United Methodist Church Norman, Oklahoma

At BridgeView United Methodist Church, Rev. David Poteet leads his congregation at their Norman shopping center location. Since BridgeView was established in 2000, they have grown to having two services and more than 100 in worship attendance. The church purchased 30 acres of land in the growing area of northwest Norman. The congregation anticipates beginning their phase one building project soon!
